



ACHIEVING WHAT WAS CONSIDERED IMPOSSIBLE

SURAT DIAMOND BOURSE

How we completed one of the most challenging urban projects India has seen - on time

This is what made the project special

- · World's largest commercial building
- One of the first projects in Gujarat to use the Radiant Cooling System in a commercial building
- Freestanding featured wall not connected to any building, attempted for the first time in India

Big numbers of the project

- 1,850 Crore project size
- 10 Lakhs sq. ft. of common double basement
- 10,00,000 sq. ft. of facade glazing
- 66 Lakhs sq. ft. of constructed space
- 5,00,000 Cubic meters of concrete (average 670 cum per day)
- 20,00,000 sq. ft. of stone cladding
- 20 Lakhs sq. ft. of car and two-wheeler parking
- 52,000 Tons of reinforcement steel (average 80 tons per day for 24 months)
- 4,200 Number of offices

Overview

When PSP was awarded the turnkey contract for the Rs. 1,575 Crore (concluded value Rs. 1,839 Crore) Surat Diamond Bourse in 2017, the industry whisper was that the company had bitten off more than it could chew.

There were good reasons for this conclusion.

The size of this project was 6x the previous largest project completed by the company and 4x of the previous years' revenue. The project warranted construction of the "world's largest office building" on a single basement having 6.6 Mn Sq.Ft. The project was required to be completed in just 36 months.



Knowledge Corner - Case Study

The fine print was as challenging. To begin with, the project warranted mass excavation of 15 Lakhs c.mt footprint of 10,00,000 sq. ft. at a 12m depth (marked by groundwater pressure as the project is close to the sea). The deployment of 40 excavators for three months helped drain ground water. Besides, the Covid-19 pandemic brought work to a standstill for almost six months.

The company responded with a strategic business unit dedicated to the project (comprising three departments for monitoring, control and implementation – Naming SDB1, SDB2 & SDB3). A senior vice president was stationed at the site to address challenges in real-time. Day-by-day construction schedules were outlined. A sequenced workflow was created that was reviewed by the top management on weekly bases. The company established funding lines to ensure that equipment and other supports were procured on time. A back-end finance team coordinated with the client for timely milestone payments to keep the project moving. The company deployed a peak labour pool of 8000+ people and technical staff of 550. The project consists of Not Only Civil but also the MEP, Façade and General Development Team. A factory of 50,000 Sq.Ft. was established dedicated to the Glazing Fabrication works to ensure timely production with quality. PSP team meticulously planned the sequential activities, and ensured uninterrupted workflow and the project is delivered with highest standard of quality.

The result of this planning, discipline and urgency was that the company completed India's largest and possibly most challenging urban commercial project on schedule. The project that had commenced in December 2018 was completed in October 2022. More importantly, the company validated its spirit that 'There is nothing at PSP that is considered impossible.'


